Weather for July 2023

Rainfall: July was a very wet month with well over twice the normal rainfall and 5 days of rain over 10 mm. Despite this no serious flooding was noted around the village. August has started with a few wet days ensuring there won't be any hosepipe bans this summer with the reservoirs in Devon well stocked in August.

Temperatures: The temperatures during July were close to the historical mean both during the day and night. So far in August they have continued the trend so no heat waves yet this summer.

Weather elsewhere: Wild fires in the N. Hemisphere are the topic of the month with Greece, Italy, Portugal and of course Hawaii all affected. The latter experienced flames fanned by a passing typhoon which combined with vegetation parched by a dry summer was a deadly combination with over a 100 fatalities so far reported. Scientists have reported that the global mean July 2023 temperature was a record with several heat waves (>45 degC) in southern Europe contributing to it.
