**Rainfall:** Both November and first half of December have been much drier than normal with no big rain storms. The second half of December looks as if it will be much wetter in time for Christmas.

**Temperatures:** November was close to average but December is shaping up to be well above the norm so no white Christmas in prospect.

**Weather elsewhere:** The biggest storm surge for more than 60 years hit along the east coast of England on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December. In 1953 a lesser surge resulted in 307 fatalities in England. The reason the impact was much less this time was due to much better warnings well in advance and the flood defences put in place since 1953 protecting 800,000 homes. North America has been getting much heavier snow than usual in early December with snow even as far south as Texas.
