

# Payhembury Weather

**Rainfall:** After the drought in the spring it came to a dramatic end on 18 June with around 50mm of rain in 24 hours and twice the normal rainfall for June. Normally 50mm would have caused serious flooding but as things were so dry the run-off was reduced. The gardens benefited from this rain. July has been a lot drier so far with mainly light rain.

**Temperatures:** There were a few really warm days in June reaching 29 degC on 25 June but in contrast on 9 June the temperature dipped to 5 degC, unusually cold for a summer night.

**Weather elsewhere:** At least 50 people have been killed and more than two million affected by heavy monsoon flooding in the north-eastern Indian state of Assam. Also heavy floods and landslides have devastated southwestern Japan and left dozens dead. Wuhan the infamous city in China has also been flooded on 12-13 July. Meanwhile 19 people were rushed to hospitals in Maryland after a tree fell on a garage during a thunderstorm, trapping them. The first half of 2020 has seen record warm temperatures in the Arctic Circle which the Met Office has said is almost impossible without climate change.
