Weather for June 2022

Rainfall: After a dry 3 weeks the rain finally came in the last week of June to provide a normal month's of rain. Since then the first two and a half weeks of July have been dry with higher temperatures.

Temperatures: There was one really warm day on 17th June reaching almost 31 degC but in contrast on the night of the 1st of June it got down to 1.6 degC close to an air frost in June! The Met Office issued an amber warning of extreme heat for Devon on 18th July and it reached 32.6 degC in Payhembury which is not quite the highest temperature I have recorded of 33.1 degC in 2013.

Weather elsewhere: The record breaking heat waves in Portugal, Spain and France have led to many wildfires breaking out risking lives and causing many to evacuate their homes. In contrast a powerful winter storm stranded more than 300 vehicles in the Andes mountains near the Argentina-Chile border on 9th July. At least 7 people were killed caught in an avalanche sparked by the collapse of the Marmolada glacier in the northern Italian Alps on 3rd July. There is dramatic footage of this on social media.
