Weather for June 2023

Rainfall: June was a very dry month with less than half the normal rainfall. Most of the rain fell on 20 June. July in contrast is shaping up to be a wet month with 24mm on 14th July.

Temperatures: The average June daytime temperature was almost 6 degC above the 1960-90 mean value which is exceptional. The temperature exceeded +30 degC on 13 June. The Met Office announced that June was the hottest June on record over the U.K. July has started with cooler temperatures.

Weather elsewhere: The period from 3-6 July recorded a record high global mean temperature of 17.2 degC. This will probably be exceeded again soon. Several areas are undergoing searing heat waves in early July including countries around the Mediterranean, India, the southern U.S. and China. One factor driving this is the developing El Nino ocean circulation in the Tropical Pacific. Meanwhile South Korea has experienced torrential rain with 39 fatalities of which 13 bodies were recovered from a flooded road tunnel. Finally Johannesburg experienced its first snowfall in over a decade in early July.
