

# Payhembury Weather

**Rainfall:** The month of May and so far in June have been 2 months of big contrast in rainfall. May had a third of the normal rain so the gardens were beginning to suffer. June however has had 3 times the normal rainfall in the first 2 weeks so now everything is soggy. On 7 June we had 28 mm of rain. June 2019 could be breaking records for the amount of rain if it continues.

**Temperatures:** In May days were warm and nights were cold gradually warming through the month. June however has been noticeably cool so far with all the rain.

**Weather elsewhere:** Several areas further north in the U.K. were subject to flooding from the heavy rain in early June. Southern China has also been suffering from severe floods with 61 people killed and 356,000 evacuated from their homes along the Yangtze river. On 10 June a severe hail storm hit Bavaria with hail the size of golf balls injuring several people and causing much damage. Finally in Delhi temperatures have risen to over 45 degC to new records causing much distress among the population.
