Weather for May 2023

Rainfall: May was a month of 2 halves with a lot of rain on 8th-9th May and no rain in the second half. Overall May had only 20% less rainfall than usual. June continued the dry weather resulting in 25 continuous days of no rain. Finally some rain fell on 10 June, but not enough to irrigate the garden, and then another dry week.

Temperatures: May was much warmer during the day than normal but nighttime temperatures were close to normal with one night getting down to just above freezing. June has warmed up with a maximum of over 30 degC on 13th June.

Weather elsewhere: Although Payhembury had very little rain in June thunderstorms on 11th June caused flooding in the Midlands and parts of northern England. Large wildfires have been raging across Western Canada, burning close to a million acres. They have forced the evacuation of tens of thousands of residents. Large plumes of smoke produced by the fires have stretched across N. America, significantly impacting air quality in several areas. New York City experienced hazardous air quality levels on 6th June.
