Rainfall: October continued the wet theme of this Autumn with 20% more rainfall than average. November however started drier than average but it was only be a temporary respite with significant rainfall on 20th November causing the lanes to flood again.

Temperatures: It has been slightly warmer than the long term average during October. The slight frosts have not been severe enough to kill our Fuscias though.

Weather elsewhere: Hurricane Sandy dominated the weather news earlier this month. Accurate forecasts of the track of the storm heading into New York were captured up to 9 days ahead by the European forecast model giving plenty of warning. It set records for the lowest surface pressure recorded over the eastern coastal cities. Venice was underwater more than usual on 12 November with a combination of high tides and heavy rainfall over Italy. It is claimed the city is sinking at a rate of 2mm/year so flooding will become more likely.
