**Rainfall:** September was an average month for rainfall but October has seen several deluges already with twice the normal rainfall and roads flooded again. This year has been exceptional in that it was very dry up to April and then very wet thereafter.

**Temperatures:** Generally warmer in September and so far in October than the 1960-90 average. We had the first frost of the Autumn on 14 October.

**Sunshine:** This September was actually sunnier than last year but overall the summer was about the same as last year.

**Weather elsewhere:** Monday the 15 October was the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the great October storm made famous by Michael Fish now an icon of British weather forecasting. Some of you may have memories of that night especially if you lived in the south east at the time. Some coastal towns in Devon suffered flooding on 17<sup>th</sup> October due to a combination of high tides and strong winds.
