Rainfall: The relatively dry weather continues from September into October with the first 2 weeks of October with hardly any rain. October rain has finally arrived though as I write this. The summer as a whole in the south west has only had around 80% of the normal rainfall.

Temperatures: September was 2 degC warmer than normal with a southerly airflow from the Continent but October has started cooler with the wind coming from the east. There are 2 days missing for the October figures. For the summer as a whole it was just slightly warmer than normal in the south west.

Weather elsewhere: Hurricane Matthew has caused devastation in Haiti and serious flooding along the SE states of the U.S. This was followed by Hurricane Nicole which headed for Bermuda and caused disruption. The minimum in the Arctic sea-ice cover for this year was the fifth lowest on record at least for the satellite era.
