

# Payhembury Weather

**Rainfall:** August surprisingly came out about average for rainfall after a few days of heavy rain. September has started very dry again though.

**Temperatures:** August and early September have both been warmer during the day than average but also cooler at night. It was only 2 degC in my garden on the early morning of 13 September, almost a frost.

**Weather elsewhere:** The hurricane and typhoon season is well under with Florence in the Atlantic battering the Carolinas in the U.S. with serious flooding and even bigger and more powerful was typhoon Mangkhut with winds of 115 mph and storm surges on 14 September which damaged part of the Philippines and buildings in Hong Kong. July this year has seen extreme high temperatures at many locations in the N. Hemisphere (e.g. Algeria 51.3 degC, Furnace Creek, California 52.0 degC) and we are likely to be heading for one of the warmest summers on record.
