

# Payhembury Weather

**Rainfall:** Taking August as a whole there was nearly 3 times the usual rainfall with the biblical rain on 13 August ending the heatwave and there were some other decent downpours later in the month. September has been pretty dry for the first 3 weeks.

**Temperatures:** August was warmer than average mainly due to a heatwave around 11 August which lasted a few days with near record temperatures at 31.9 degC. The middle of September has also produced some very warm days for September reaching 26.9 degC on 14<sup>th</sup>.

**Weather elsewhere:** Several Typhoons in the Pacific have been affecting Japan and the Korean peninsula. Typhoon Maysak sank the Gulf Livestock 1 cargo ship which was carrying 43 crew members and 6,000 cows with many drowned. Elsewhere 2 million acres were burned by wildfires in California which surpassed all-time records set in 2018 and there were several fatalities. The smoke from the fires was seen as far east as New York. In contrast Hurricane Sally has caused serious flooding in the southern U.S.
