Weather for August 2023

**Rainfall:** August was a fairly wet month with rain days spread through the month which was great for the gardens and crops, less so for the holiday makers. September started with 2 weeks of almost no rain until 16/17 September when 70 mm was recorded which is more than normal for the whole month.

**Temperatures:** The daytime temperatures in August were slightly above normal but night-time cooler. No mid-summer heat waves. However as soon as the schools went back in September the temperature rose with 9 consecutive days above 25 degC.

**Weather elsewhere:** Some places in the UK had an unprecedented seven consecutive days above 30 degC in September according to the Met Office with Heathrow reaching 32.7 degC on the 9<sup>th</sup>. The terrible flooding in Libya has caused untold suffering. It was caused by Storm Daniel which was classified as a "Medicane" which has characteristics like a Hurricane with a central eye but forms over the Mediterranean. It caused serious floods in Greece also. There is concern over the coverage of the Antarctic sea-ice this southern winter which is lower than ever seen before.
